

# Program Description

We teach a play to learn program with an academic skill. We have an online parent exchange system to send parents pictures of their children all day as well as a report on the daily needs (food, Diapering, sleep) etc. each night.

Our program is designed to create a safe stimulating environment where children are encouraged to learn, grow, and explore using all of their senses. Our high-quality early childhood educators provide numerous educational activities daily that are fun, educational, and developmentally appropriate. At Kudos 2 Kids we focus on the whole child and provide a program that enhances skills in the 5 domains, Physical, Intellectual, Language, Emotional and Social. We have developed a program that focus on the whole child and is based on science. We promote a healthy lifestyle in our children through our nutrition homemade menu, our rest and relation program, daily physical activity, and mental health. We role model and encourage independence, self regulation, risky play, friendships, co-operation, exploration, discovery because we believe our children are competent, curious, and capable.

Our Toddler/Preschool program curriculum includes daily materials that helps develop all the following skills in our children.

- Group Activities - Enhances language, memory, imagination, self-expression, and collaboration of shared ideas.
- Library Area - Develop interest in books, reading, comprehension, speech, story telling and listening.
- Jolly Phonics - Learning letters and words through multi-sensory teaching . Preschool workbooks for exposure to pre-writing and literacy recognition.
- Mathematics - Recognition of numbers, counting, sequencing, patterns, individual and large group activities. Preschool Workbooks for Fulltime children for letter recognition, concepts and writing skills.
- Dramatic Play - Developing co-operative play, social development, language, and imagination.
- Creative - Creative activities for self-expression & imagination through various manipulation of mediums.
- Sensory - Exploring with all five senses: sight, sound, smell, taste & touch.
- Nature/Science - Questioning, experimenting, cause and effect and discover the world around us.
- Gross Motor Activities - Indoor activities to develop muscle control, balance and co-ordination.
- Outdoor Classroom - Discovering our community, group play skills, Gross motor activities and learning from our outdoor classroom
- Social and Community Events – Special Days, field trips, special guests, special events, parent and community functions.

We understand that in all of these activities there needs to be social and emotional connections between our educator and the child. Our educators reach out to create a bond and a trusting relationship with each child, as part of helping the child to grow as an individual.
